Conditions

1. Boys must be 9, 10 or 11 on January 1, 2012 (born in 2000, 2001 or 2002). Photocopy of birth certificate from first time registrants required for placement.
2. Boys living in, or attending school in Leaside have priority. Non residents of Leaside will be placed in order of the receipt date of their application after all Leaside applicants have been placed.
3. Any boy playing in the L.A.B.A. cannot play in any other organized baseball (hardball) program.
4. A boy may submit an application both to the L.A.B.A. and Leaside Baseball Association Pee wee League. If he makes a PEEWEE team, his L.A.B.A. fee will be refunded.

Time Commitment

- League play opens in late April and includes a Spring playoff which runs until the end of Public School in June. Playoffs continue in September for 2 to 3 weeks after Labour Day.
- All games are played at Trace Manes Park and may be scheduled on any week night and Saturdays (Sundays for rainouts). Each team plays an average of three games every two weeks including most Saturdays. A schedule will be provided prior to the start of league play. September playoffs are scheduled as required on any day of the week.

General Information

- Players assigned to teams will be called by a coach about April 22. Normally some players are assigned late. Fees will be returned by May 15 to players not assigned to teams.
- Fifteen players are assigned to each team. Batting order is 1-15 as determined by the coach. Each player is guaranteed to play in the field a minimum of 50% of the innings.
- Players must wear their team sweater and cap to participate.
- Players must supply their own baseball glove and running shoes. Cleats of any kind cannot be used. Shorts cannot be worn.
- Bats, balls, helmets, and catchers' equipment are provided by the L.A.B.A. Only bats supplied by the L.A.B.A. can be used and only helmets supplied by the L.A.B.A. can be worn. Catchers must wear a protective cup.
- The L.A.B.A. adheres to the Baseball Ontario Code of Conduct available on their website.
